Content

- 100 mL CaLoSiL® E5 (lime content 5 g/L)
- 100 mL CaLoSiL® IP5 (lime content 5 g/L)
- 100 mL CaLoSiL® E grey
- 20 mL CaLoSiL® paste-like



Use

The sample box contains selected types of CaLoSiL® which are suitable for the consolidation of powdering surfaces, wall painting and frescos.

CaLoSiL® E5, CaLoSiL® IP5

CaLoSiL® E5 is used for the consolidation of powdering surfaces. Loose particles as well as pigments are glued together and fixed on the surface.

CaLoSiL® IP5 needs longer time for the evaporation of the solvent. Deeper penetration and higher strengthening is possible. This depends, however, in many cases also on the structure of the material to be treated.

CaLoSiL® E grey

It is used for deep structural strengthening as well as for the consolidation of surfaces. Due to its low viscosity CaLoSiL® E grey is especially suitable for applications on surfaces. The tendency to form white hazes is extremely low in comparison to other products.

CaLoSiL® paste-like

CaLoSiL® paste-like is a high concentrated nano-lime product. The solvent is ethanol as in all products of the CaLoSiL® E - series. It is used to fill small cracks, joints or openings. It can also be used to glue loose particles together or to stabilise detachments. Mixing with fillers such as marble or limestone powder offers the possibility to prepare special injection grouts or repair mortars. It can be diluted by the addition of ethanol or isopropanol to any desired final concentration.

Safety

CaLoSiL® grey is flammable and combustible. Keep away from oxidisers, heat, sparks and flames. Avoid spilling, skin and eye contact. Ventilate well, avoid breathing vapours. CaLoSiL® grey reacts strongly alkaline. Do not breathe vapour or mist. Do not smoke. Keep container closed. Use with adequate ventilation. Wash thoroughly after handling. Keep away from sources of ignition. Please store in a cool and dry place in a
